Supporting the community

We regularly attend and host Meet the Buyer Events with our supply chain and have done since 2006.



We engage with social enterprises where possible. Most recently, Spruce Carpets removed existing flooring from our fit out project in Glasgow City Centre salvaging 2,318m² of re-usable carpet tiles. The remaining 4,304m² was recycled.

We aim to utilise local subs on our projects to keep the money within the community. On our recent £4m school refurbishment and extension for Renfrewshire Council, 70% of the subcontractor orders were placed within a 30 mile radius of the site.



We held a free SME Advice Event at Saltcoats Town Hall in January 2018 as part of our commitment to the community through our project at Quarry Road for North Ayrshire Council.

We run annual foodbank collections which most recently resulted in a collection of 460kg of food which was then shared between 10 Trussell Trust foodbanks across the country.



Every Clark Contracts employee is given one paid day off per year to volunteer with a charity. So far in 2018 we have supported the ACCORD Hospice, St Vincent's Hospice, Downs Syndrome Scotland, Glasgow City Mission and Marie Curie.
