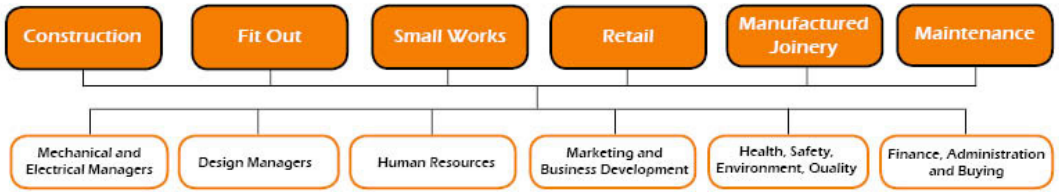


Introduction to Clark Contracts

Clark Contracts was founded in 1978 and over the past 43 years the firm has diversified and moved into specialist areas of construction, refurbishment and maintenance across the UK.



Construction

Our Construction Division delivers construction and refurbishment projects ranging from £1m to £20m with an annual turnover of over £50m.

Fit Out

Our Fit Out Division specialises in office fit outs, occupied and shell projects ranging from £1m to £20m. This division's annual turnover is approximately £15m.

Small Works

Our Small Works Division delivers construction and refurbishment projects up to £1m. This team typically delivers between 50 - 60 projects per year and has an annual turnover of approximately £20m.

Retail

Our Retail Division specialises in construction and refurbishment projects within the Retail sector, ranging from £1m to £20m with an annual turnover of £5m.

Our Manufactured Joinery Division

Our experienced team manufacture bespoke products to the highest standard utilising traditional and modern techniques, from estimating and design development through to production, final installation and fitting.

Maintenance

Our Maintenance Division provides multi-trade, planned, preventative and reactive maintenance across Scotland.



Consistency in delivery

- Our repeat business has averaged 76% over the past 5 years.

Taking responsibility for the environment in which we work

We pro-actively manage our environmental impact:

- ISO 14001:2015 accredited.
- Site Waste Management Plans are implemented on all our projects.
- Our diversion from landfill in 2020 was in excess of 99%
- We track the fuel consumption of our fleet of company vans weekly.
- We generate 23% of our own electricity through solar panels on the roof of our Head Office.

Investing in our people...

- We were awarded the ‘Best Place to Work’ award at the UK Construction News Talent Awards 2019.
- We have a dedicated Learning and Development Manager.
- We annually invest over £750k on training our employees and in 2019 we made an initial investment of £11k in mental health training for staff.
- Healthy Working Lives Silver accredited employer.
- Over 20% of our employees are currently studying towards formal qualifications at college or university.
- We are now an Approved Training Organisation allowing us to deliver training in-house.
- We offer all employees one paid day per year which they can use to volunteer for a registered charity.
